BULLS AND HEIFERS RAISED AT THE RANCH OF ORIGIN AND/OR PERFORMANCE TESTED AT THE RANCH OR A TEST STATION HEIFERS PURCHASED FOR DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS

Boehringer Ingelheim Vetmedica, Inc. provides a limited health warranty on bulls and/or replacement heifers that have met the requirements of the Range Ready Program and are sold into U.S. breeding herds.

The warranty only applies to the antigens listed below when the Range Ready Vaccination protocol is followed, the vaccines administered appear on the Range Ready qualifying product list, and the animals are enrolled in the Range Ready Program.

Range Ready Limited Warranty Coverage

Boehringer Ingelheim Vetmedica, Inc. warrants the health of the animal (minimum age requirement 10 months) for 6 months past the animal's last vaccination if the animal has been enrolled in the Range Ready Program and has met the program requirements.

- If a qualifying animal becomes sick due to disease caused by an antigen covered in the required vaccination protocol, **Boehringer Ingelheim Vetmedica, Inc.** will reimburse the producer for treatment costs and veterinary services related to diagnosis.*
- If a qualifying animal dies due to disease caused by an antigen covered in the required vaccination protocol, **Boehringer Ingelheim Vetmedica, Inc.** will reimburse the producer for treatment costs, veterinary services related to diagnosis, and fair market value of the animal at the time of death up to a maximum of \$3,500.00 per animal.**

Range Ready Warranty Eligibility Requirements

- Animals must be on a level of nutrition (protein, energy, minerals and vitamins) that allows them to maintain good health.
- Bulls and heifers raised on the ranch must receive the required vaccines as outlined in the vaccination protocol starting at 2-3 months of age until they are sold.
- Heifers purchased for development must receive the required vaccines as outlined in the vaccination protocol until they are sold.
- Animals must be individually identified using a visual tamper-proof and/or RFID tag, and, if applicable, a tattoo number, brucellosis tag number and/or breed registration number.
- All animals must be tested and confirmed BVD persistent infection (PI) negative to be eligible.
- Bulls and heifers raised at the ranch must be enrolled in the Range Ready Program through the web site www.rangeready.us or by mail prior to weaning. Purchased heifers must be enrolled within 2 weeks of initial vaccinations.
- All documentation on the enrollment form must be completed for the animal to be eligible.
- Signed confirmation from a practicing veterinarian that the above requirements have been met (if enrolled through the website a certificate from the veterinarian must be mailed in) prior to sale.
- Any animal covered by this warranty shall be weaned a minimum of 60 days prior to sale.

Documentation Required

- **Original Owner**
 - Owner's name, mailing address, e-mail address if applicable and contact numbers.
 - Owner's premise ID number if available.
 - Each animal's visual tamper-proof ID and/or RFID tag number, and, if applicable, a tattoo number, brucellosis tag number and/or breed registration number.
 - Each animal's date of birth.
 - Date, product name, serial number, expiration date and administration route of each vaccine used.
- **New Owner**
 - Signed confirmation from a licensed veterinarian & contact information for the veterinarian.
 - Owner's name, mailing address, e-mail address if applicable and contact numbers.
 - Owner's premise ID number if available.
 - Each animal's visual tamper-proof ID and/or RFID tag number, and, if applicable, a tattoo number, brucellosis tag number and/or breed registration number.
 - Number of heifers and/or bulls purchased.
 - Operation's attending licensed veterinarian & contact information.
